2. Golf tournament will be 18 holes medal play in one day. Men and Women will compete on separate days.
3. Local golf club rules will also be in effect.
4. Carts are included and are mandatory.

Playing Rules

1. Starting times will be assigned by golf officials and will be posted at the golf course and at the Sports Information Table.
2. USGA/PGA dress code will be enforced.
3. Golfers must provide their own clubs.
4. Scratch play will be in effect. No handicaps will be used.
5. In case of a tie, score card playoff will be used. (See Sport Coordinator for specifications.)
6. Only athletes meeting NSGA's Minimum Performance Standards at Summer Games will qualify to attend Nationals.
7. No golf fee refund will be made after the refund deadline. **No exceptions.**
8. All athletes will pay greens fees at the time of registering for New Mexico Senior Olympics Annual Summer Games regardless of local membership status.
