Disc Golf Rules

Playing Format

1. **Disc Golf** will be conducted in accordance with PDGA (Professional Disc Golf Association) Rules and National Senior Games Association except as noted below. For complete rules please contact:

2. The Disc Golf tournament will consist of 18 hole's stroke play.
3. Event will be singles.
4. Equipment will be furnished by Sport Coordinator. Participants may also use their own discs.

Playing Rules

1. Scratch play will be in effect. No handicaps will be used.
2. Tee throw from the marked tee box. The lead foot should not go past the end of the teeing area. Subsequent throws are made from wherever the disc lands after each throw.
3. After a throw the disc position must be marked either by using a mini or leaving the disc as is.
4. A foot or other anchor point must stay behind the disc when throwing.
5. Continue in this manner until the disc is either in the chains or the basket.
6. Count each throw and enter on the score card in the appropriate spot.
7. Any disc going into water, street, parking lot, or other area as designated is considered as Out of Bounds. Play from where the disc last crossed Out of Bounds and add one stroke for that hole.
8. In the event of a tie between 1st, 2nd or 3rd place, the tie-breaking procedure of matching scorecards will be implemented. The player with the best score on the last nine holes will win the higher medal. If players have the same score for the 9 holes, the last 6 holes will be compared, then 3 holes and then finally the 18th hole.
9. Rule specifics can be found in the PDGA rule book.
