

## **GAME INFORMATION**

New Mexico Senior Olympics (NMSO) is excited to expand the State Games for senior athletes and offer State Games-North (SGN) in Santa Fe on January 13-16, 2025, for fifteen sports. SGN will be offered as an annual event. The Annual State Summer Games will take place in June 2025, in Las Cruces, NM, as we have done for forty years.

Athletes must register in advance for State Games-North, and games are open to anyone age 50 and older, by December 31, 2025. State Games-North will follow the same sport playing rules and standard registration practices/procedures that have been adopted by the Board of Directors for the Annual State Summer Games. Athletes are encouraged to increase and Games both competitiveness for a greater performance. NMSO Game Management reserves the right to cancel any sport on the competition schedule, that does not Check the NMSO merit sufficient registrants. website at www.nmseniorolympics.org for all final game information to include, schedule, sport rules, Out-of-state format, and deadlines. playing participants are welcome to compete in sports offered at NSGA. Deadline to register for State Games-North is December 20, 2024.

## **SCHEDULING**

Check for ongoing Schedule and Game updates on the NMSO website at www.nmseniorolympics.org. Game time is forfeit time. It is the athletes' responsibility to carefully select their events to avoid conflicts for their competition. Play will not be held up. In the event an athlete competes out of scheduled times, athletes' risk being disqualified.

## MEDICAL INSURANCE

Medical/Health Insurance is the responsibility of each participant. Every participant should be sure to have proof of insurance in case of an emergency.

## **ATHLETE CHECK-IN**

It is highly recommended athletes check in to pick up game credentials. Athletes will need a photo ID with their date of birth. Athlete Check-In will be at the Santa Fe Convention Center, located at 201 W. Marcy St. Operation hours for check-in are reflective on the competition schedule. Athlete check-in will include sports information tables for each

competition.

An athlete cannot check-in for another athlete. In the event an athlete cannot come by the Convention Center, you may go directly to your competition, knowing you will be required to present a photo ID at the sport venue to check-in.

## **CHECK-IN AT SPORT VENUE**

At each sport venue is a check-in table with an event listing/sign-in of eligible registered competitors. Every athlete must check-in and sign on the line next to their name. This will be confirmation that the athlete is registered in that sport/event. In the event an athlete does not appear on the event listing, the athlete may produce an entry confirmation form or call Game Headquarters for verification of registration for that sport/event.

## PARKING

Adequate parking will be allowed at the various venues. The Santa Fe Convention Center does have a parking facility located underneath the Center with reasonable rates. For those choosing to take public transportation, the most convenient bus stop is in the next block south of the SFCC, on Sheridan Street. Many hotels offer complimentary shuttles. A taxi service is also available.

## **AGE DIVISION**

Participants will register according to their age as of December 31, 2025. Age categories are in five-year age divisions, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99 and 100+. Partner events age categories are: 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+, 80+, 85+, 90+. Age categories for doubles and teams will be determined by the youngest player as of December 31, 2025.

## **EVENT CHANGES**

Registration event change(s) are allowed, when an athlete requests to drop or add an event, or to request a partner change. Event and partner changes must be received in writing, or by email by December 20, 2024. A telephone call requesting a change(s) is no longer valid. Athletes are responsible for verifying their request for change(s) are received and processed.

## GAME INFORMATION CONTINUED...

## **PARTNER EVENT(S)**

A partner's name must be indicated on the entry form to be processed. In the event a partner is not listed for the event, you will not be entered in that event until partner information is provided. If your partner does not register for the event by the final registration deadline of December 20, 2024, you will be removed from that event and receive a new entry confirmation by email. NMSO is not responsible for finding partners for athletes.

Partner changes can be requested through December 20<sup>th</sup>. After this date, partner changes can only be made on-site provided the reason for change meets the following criteria.

- 1. Partner is out due to a medical reason or injury; documentation will be required.
- 2. Partner did not attend the Games.

Partner can be changed if it does not change the age category, and the new partner is registered for the Games. On-site partner change(s) are to be made thirty minutes prior to game time with the Sport Coordinator at the sport venue and confirmed by Game Headquarters with a phone call.

## **SPORT COORDINATORS**

Sport Coordinators are NMSO's ambassadors/sport enthusiast contracted to run sporting events for New Mexico Senior Olympics and are working as volunteers. Athletes may contact Sport Coordinators after December 20th for any specific tournament format that is not addressed in the athlete registration booklet. Sport Coordinators cannot and will not accommodate individual athlete's schedule onsite and are required to adhere to posted event schedules. In the event an athlete competes out of scheduled times, athletes will risk being disqualified.

## **DEADLINES/CANCELLATIONS**

Registrations are accepted through December 20<sup>th</sup> at the end of business day, with no late registration's options, due to the short time of planning State Game - North. All registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.

## PROTEST POLICY

Protests must be submitted in writing to the Sport Coordinator, and Game Headquarters, within 24 hours of the event. Game Management and Arbitrators will review and render a final decision, which cannot be appealed.

## **SPECTATORS**

Spectators are welcome but must avoid interfering with athletes, as this could result in disqualification.

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Games will proceed rain or shine unless deemed unsafe. Contact your Sports Coordinator for updates. No refunds for weather-related cancellations.

## **AWARDS**

Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded per age division and gender. Only athletes competing in their scheduled age group are eligible. Athletes are encouraged to stay for award presentations, or medals may be picked up by the athlete or local coordinator. Unclaimed medals will be available at Game Headquarters through Thursday at 10:00 AM. Afterward, check with your local coordinator. Full rules on awards, tiebreakers, etc., are in the NMSO official rulebook, section R.

## **GAME RESULTS**

Sports Coordinators will provide game results to Headquarters for posting, with results considered preliminary until verified. Results will be posted on the NMSO website and shared with local media. Results are adopted by the NMSO Board at their annual October meeting.

## **NATIONALS**

The NMSO State Games serves as a National Senior Games qualifier in even-numbered years. Nationals will be held July 24-August 4, 2025 in Des Moines, IA, with over 10,000 athletes expected. For more information, visit www.nsga.com.

## HOW TO REGISTER STATE GAMES-NORTH

There are three ways to register for the Senior Olympics State Games – North paper form, online, or through group registration.

#### PAPER FORM

Fill out the paper registration in ink, sign, keep a copy for your records and mail to NMSO. Payment must be included. NMSO is not responsible for lost mail. Contact the office if you don't receive a confirmation email.

#### ONLINE REGISTRATION

Register at <u>www.nmseniorolympics.org</u> or scan the QR code. You will need an email address and credit card.

   New athletes will have accounts created.
- ✓ Select up to 3 sports.
- ✓ Review your selections before finalizing registration.
- ✓ Pay with a debit/credit card to complete registration.

Both athletes must register separately for your event to be valid. Your partner will receive an email to register. Please note that NMSO does not assist in finding partners for partner events.

#### CONFIRMATION

A receipt will be emailed, as will an event confirmation. Keep a printed copy. You can use the confirmation number to update your registration later if needed.

#### GROUP REGISTRATIONS

Local game sites have registration booklets. Athletes can get help completing forms or request a group mailing via their local game coordinator. Confirm your entry with NMSO, as local sites are not responsible for lost or misdirected mail.

## **SPORT RULES UPDATES**

## **SPORT RULES**

For 2025 State Games-North, athletes are not required to qualify at local games to register for State Games-North. For general playing rules and specific sport rules and descriptions visit the New Mexico Senior Olympics website at www.nmseniorolympics.org.

It is the responsibility of each athlete to know playing rules in advance. See rules for exhibition games. Athletes can register for a maximum of three (3) sports with an unlimited number of events in each sport. NMSO may place a cap on the total number of entries for Pickleball and Shuffleboard due to the growing numbers in these Sports. Out-of-state athletes are welcome to register for the 2025 State Games-North in the sports that are offered by National Senior Games.

NMSO Game Management reserves the right to cancel a sport on the Competition Schedule that does not meet the required number of registrants to conduct the sport(s).

## **EXHIBITON SPORTS**

2025 State Games-North will offer 3 Exhibition Sports – Ice Hockey (team sport), Power Lifting and Tai Chi. All 3 Exhibition Sports will be held at the Genoveva Chavez Community Center, see schedule.

#### **AIR GUN**

Equipment - COMPETITORS MUST FURNISH REGULATION AIR GUNS AND ALL PERSONAL EQUIPMENT NEEDED FOR THIS EVENT (EXCLUDING TARGETS). NMSO will not furnish rifles and pistols for competition. Caliber of air guns will be .177" (4.5 mm). Only soft lead pellets will be used. Air Guns must be cased at all times when not being used in competition. Personal air guns must be in the control of the competitor at all times in the event area.

#### **CORNHOLE**

**Events** - Athletes may compete in singles, men's doubles, women's doubles, and mixed doubles. Doubles must be two individuals of the same gender. Mixed Doubles must be one male and one female.

**Distance of the Boards -** Age 80-84 – 23 feet front edge to front edge 85 Plus/Non-Ambulatory – 21 feet front edge to front edge.

## **Mini Sport Descriptions**

AIR GUN - conducted in accordance with the rules of the National Rifle Association (NRA) (Precision Air Rifle Rules and International Style Pistol Rules) and the New Mexico Senior Olympics. Competitors must furnish regulation air guns, and all personal equipment needed for this event (excluding targets).



**BASKETBALL SKILLS 3 POINT SHOT AND FREE THROW** - an official size basketball will be used. The rim will be 10' high.



**BILLIARDS EIGHT (8) BALL POOL** - governed by standard rules recommended by the Billiard Congress of America. Singles play only in a double elimination tournament.



**BOWLING** - will be conducted in accordance with US Bowling Congress. This is a singles, doubles and mixed doubles tournament open to men and women.



**CORNHOLE** - All sport equipment will be provided for competitors and must be used. Athletes may compete in singles, men's doubles, women's doubles, and mixed doubles.



**FRISBEE** ACCURACY - object of the Game: Throw the Frisbee disc through a large hoop opening to earn points and score the highest points in each age division for men and for women.



**HUACHAS (WASHERS)** - all sport equipment will be provided for competitors and must be used. Event will be singles. Playing format will be double elimination or round robin tournaments.



**ICE HOCKEY- EXHIBITION** – this will be a team event.



**PICKLEBALL** - will be conducted in accordance with the USA Pickleball Association rules. Events will be singles, doubles and mixed doubles.



**POWER LIFTING RULES-EXHIBITION-Squat, Bench Press, Deadlift** - will be conducted in accordance with USA Power Lifting rules. Each competitor will compete in one lifting session and is allowed three attempts on each of three lifts.



**SHUFFLEBOARD** - will be ruled in accordance with official rules of the National Shuffleboard Association, Inc. Events will be singles and doubles (doubles may be mixed or of same gender).



**SOCCER KICK ACCURACY** - players must kick from behind a **centered 10-foot line** 36 feet and parallel to the center points.



**SWIMMING** - all events shall be conducted on a timed final basis. A false start will result in disqualification. Participant may be disqualified if the correct stroke is not used.



**TABLE TENNIS** - events will be singles, doubles and mixed doubles. Contestants must use their own paddle and be in accordance with USTTA rules.



TAI CHI – EXHIBITION - competition will be conducted in accordance with USAWKF rules. Participant level of experience and mastery shall be as follows: a. Beginner – 1 year of experience or less; b. Intermediate – 1-3 years of experience; c. Advanced – 3+ years of experience.
