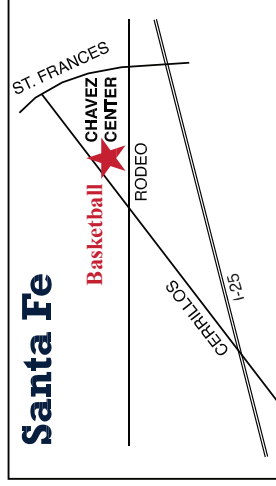

2022 Team Tournament Information

New Mexico Senior Olympics, Inc., is a NSGA sanctioned state organization and is an "Open" state for Team Tournaments: 3-on-3 Basketball, Softball, and Volleyball.

ELIGIBILITY

All team members must be 50 years of age as of December 31, 2022. The age divisions for both men and women are 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, and 75+ (80+ for 3 on 3 Basketball). No local qualifying is required.

- Team players may play in only one age category in each sport.
- Maximum roster limit includes all non-playing personnel.
- All Team Tournaments will adhere to the New Mexico Senior Olympics, Inc. official rulebook.

REGISTRATION

REGISTER ONLINE AT www.nmsseniorolympics.org

- Team Captain can register team members as long as Captain has all information, ie: Name, DOB for each member
- OR**
- Team Captain can register team and self, then each member can go online to register themselves on the team.

TEAM FEES

Team registration fee must accompany registration entry online and paperforms. Registrations will not be processed without payment. All fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express are accepted.

GAME SCHEDULING

Tournaments will begin on Saturday with a Captains meeting. Games will be scheduled Saturday (run all day/evening), and Sunday. Players plan to be with us all weekend to complete bracket play. Game Schedule will be available on the website at www.nmsseniorolympics.org one week prior to each tournament. Schedule subject to change.

EQUIPMENT

Sport Equipment will be provided for the Tournaments with the exception of balls for Softball.

ROSTER CHANGES

Captains will be limited to 3 changes to their roster after schedules are posted and before the teams first game of the tournament as long as changes do not affect age division. Arbitration committee may be consulted concerning changes. NMSO recognizes a team member may have a valid medical emergency and will attempt to work with the team to identify a replacement. NMSO will require documentation and every situation will be reviewed individually with the tournament arbitration committee.

CANCELLATIONS

NMSO officials reserve the right to reschedule, modify or cancel tournaments when required due to COVID, inclement weather, team numbers, or unplayable conditions.

TEAM CAPTAINS

- Please provide a current email address when you register your team. Team captains will receive all information concerning specific tournament by email to include brackets and game schedule.
- A Co-Captain may be designated to make changes to roster if Captain is not available.

ATHLETE CHECK-IN

All registered Athletes, Coaches and non-playing personnel must check in and sign in on-site prior to their first game of bracket game and be listed on all team line-up sheets to be considered official and registered. Required ID must include photo, birth date and gender. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS.

CREDENTIALS

Game credentials will be issued at check-in and must be worn during each game of tournament or risk being disqualified.

AWARDS

Custom medals will be awarded to 1st through 3rd place based on the number of teams in each age division. Unclaimed medals will be mailed to team captains.

Volleyball

Albuquerque Men and Women July 30-31, 2022

- Team clothing must be of like design and color and numbered in a permanent manner from 1 to 99 using Arabic numerals. Duplicate numbers are not allowed. The numbers must be placed on the jersey at the center of the front and of the back. Mini num 4 inches on the chest and minimum 6 inches on the back. Sponsors may be added to the jersey but cannot interfere with number placement. Uniforms shall be free of inappropriate symbols or wording.
- Maximum number of players on roster is 15 and includes non-playing personnel.
- Teams must furnish Line Judges and Score Keepers for games when their team is NOT playing. Schedule for Line Judges and Score Keepers will be available to captains in advance of games.

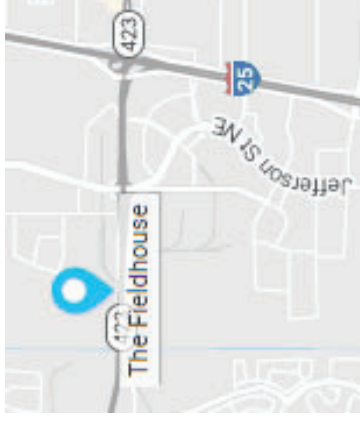

Las Cruces Men and Women October 1-2, 2022

- LAS CRUCES - Men and women will play in the same complex.
- Facilities at Paz & Maag Softball Complex, 1500 E. Hadley Ave.
- Athlete check-in must be at Maag Fields
- Team clothing must be of like design and color. An Arabic whole number (0-99) of contrasting color, or outlined in contrasting color, at least 6 inches high must be visible on the back of uniform shirts. No players on the same team may wear identical numbers. Sponsors may be added to jersey but cannot interfere with number placement. Uniforms shall be free of inappropriate symbols or wording.
- Softball teams must provide their own bats, gloves, and practice balls.
- Maximum number of players on roster is 22 and includes non-playing personnel.
- Mens Skill divisions - Division I (highest level), Division II. and Division III (recreational) if numbers warrant.
